- 5. Approval of minutes from the Regular Meeting held August 27, 2020 and the Special Meeting held September 3, 2020.
- Receive report from Executive Director/CEO and/or Port staff on activities and matters related to COVID-19 health safety
 matters, administrative affairs, financial results, facility engineering matters, operations and vessel activity, port safety
 matters, port security matters, Port tenant updates, USCOE, and other related port affairs.
- 7. Approval to sign on to a Letter of Support to the Surface Transportation Board to preserve the Staggers Rail Act, allowing freight railroads to innovate, adapt and reinvest in the rail network.

Conduct a Public Hearing regarding a proposal to set a tax rate of \$0.040100 which will increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 7.78 percent (percent by which proposed tax rate exceeds the no new revenue tax rate calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all the property and the tax rate that is adopted.
